

Capacity of the State of Minnesota's Homeless Youth Services Continuum

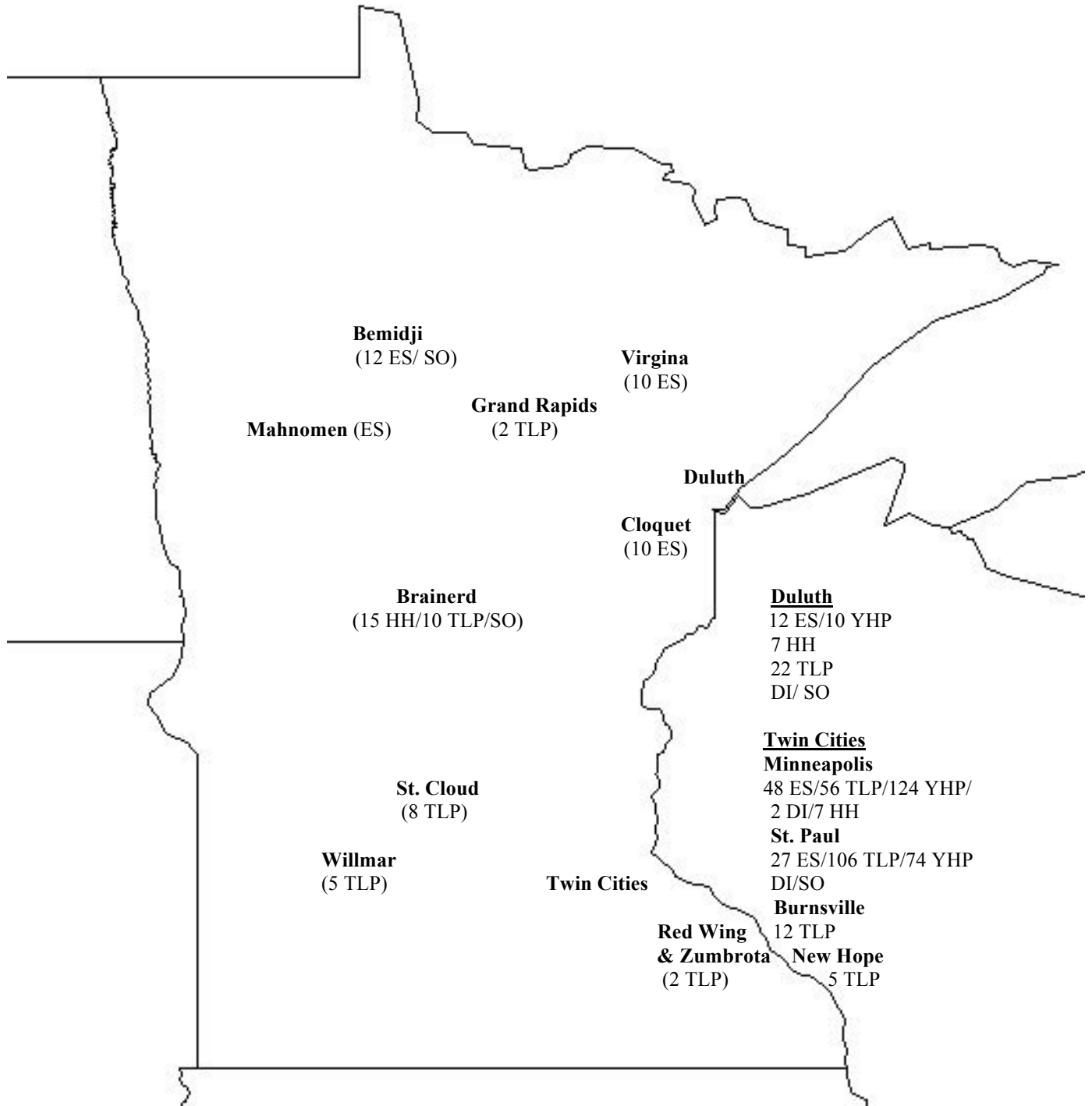
